Solar Solutions Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who owns the equipment?

The ownership of the equipment will remain with Lesedi until the end of the agreement.

2. What is the length of Agreement?

The typical length of a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) is 20 years. The client only pays for the energy that is generated.

3. Is there Insurance?

Our clients can have peace of mind that the solar system is fully covered, always monitored, and insured under the PPA.

4. How does the Maintenance work?

Maintenance services include quarterly inspections and schedule annual maintenance visits, module cleaning when solar system performance is negatively influencing our guaranteed production figures.

5. What is PPA?

A PPA is an agreement that is signed between the business owner and Lesedi. It allows the business owner to benefit from solar energy without upfront costs of buying a system, installing, and maintaining. It is basically EAAS (Energy as a Service) and covers operations, maintenance of the system, insurance, and performance guarantees.

It works as a rental, where the business owner only pays for the energy generated, with the biggest advantage being reduced electricity.
